Dear Colleague,

The William Warfield Scholarship Fund is accepting applications for its 5th Annual Classical Vocal Competition for African-American High School Students until October 6, 2023. Submissions consist of an online application, one letter of recommendation from a teacher describing musical aptitude and potential, and a Youtube or Vimeo link to a video including one selection (maximum 5 minutes).

There is no cost to apply. Five finalists will be selected to receive coaching in a virtual class with a professional vocalist on Saturday, October 21st, and submit a video for final judging by Friday, October 27th. The Final Virtual Competition will be held on Saturday, November 4th, 2023. All finalists will receive cash awards ranging from \$500 to \$2,000 to support their musical careers. Artistic merit and financial need are considered in the adjudication process.
